<b>1 We need to know that Jesus is salvation (the Passover Lamb).</b>	<b>PLOT</b>
2 We need to know that we are pilgrims who need a Passover Lamb, a Savior.	<b>PROCLAMATION</b>
3 We must remember that it is God's Plan to bring us (pilgrims) His salvation (the Passover Lamb).	<b>PILGRIM</b>
4 God told men His plan long before His plan was revealed by Jesus.	<b>PARADE</b>
5 We need to acknowledge that God's plan to conquer death and sin for all mankind is a triumphant plan. The parade is to remind us that Jesus triumphed over our enemies.	<b>PASSOVER</b>
6 Salvation comes to us when we proclaim our belief in God's plan to send us His Son (the Passover Lamb) and that Jesus was triumphant over sin and death, Jesus rose from the dead after He won the victory for us on the cross. His triumph was revealed to us by His resurrection.	<b>PLAN</b>
7 The plot of man will never succeed because Jesus is risen from the dead a triumphant King. The question is left to each of us. Will we proclaim Him as our King?	<b>PROPHECY</b>
